**Summary of minutes from Health Care**  
**Committee Meeting 3/27/06**

Our committee has been notified of a policy change by CVT regarding the conversion from Interplan to Blue Cross in October, 2006. CVT has reconsidered the previous policy of not allowing the accrued coinsurance to follow with the member, and has instead decided that the deductibles and the accrued coinsurance will follow each PPO member at the conversion time. This is good news since it was the only negative issue regarding the conversion.
