Current Site Issues:

Sub Issues within the District - the District has been short on subs this year.

Campaign 2005:

Social Committee:

Rep Council voted (with two nays and one abstention) to work with the other Bargaining Units for the end-of-the-year Retirement Party which is scheduled for May 24th.

Negotiations:

The District currently has \$5.1 million dollars in unallocated funds. It costs just over \$600,000 for all employees to receive a 1% raise. The LEA and District Bargaining Teams will be sitting down to negotiate on Monday, November 14th and Friday, November 18th. The topics for negotiations will be Salary, Benefits and Work Day.

Grievances:

The Granada Schedule Change Grievance is scheduled for Arbitration on January 12th. The District has asked to meet to discuss a possible settlement.

The Transfer of Executive Board Members Unfair Labor Practice was scheduled for a PERB hearing Thursday, Nov 3. The hearing has been delayed pending discussions of a settlement.
