Thursday, Rep Council:

- Approved a bylaw amendment to be presented to our membership prior to a vote to accept the amendment at the Feb 2 meeting.
- Heard a presentation from the LEA members of the LEA/LVJUSD Joint Evaluations Committee regarding their recommendation to the LEA and LVJUSD Bargaining Teams last fall.
- Agreed to send up to 3 members to the Livermore Adult Ed Dreamweaver class (Begins Tuesday, Jan 24th). If you are interested in the class and working on the LEA Communications committee and the LEA Website, please contact Keith Pickering-Walters.
- Heard from the LEA Professional Development Day from a committee member. They have done a tremendous amount of work toward the Elementary Staff Development Day on Jan 23. Please proof the Conference flyer prior to the day and choose which sessions you might be interested in attending. 20 people maximum in sessions, so get there early to sign up.
- Voted to recommend Ellen Taucher as a friendly incumbent.
- Approved sending our Human Rights Chairperson, Shelly Fields, and one member to the CTA Human Rights and Equity Conference in March.
